Plants Native to the United States (2018)

Following is a list of plants carried by Mary's Greenhouse that are native to the US. We tend to be conservative on the definition of the word 'native.' To us, a native is a plant that was already here in mainland America when the first Europeans arrived. This list includes plain species as well as some cultivars/selections of various native species; however, we are reluctant to add hybrids as this is an area of debate. We prefer to err on the side of caution as to whether it is a native or not so you will find other plants we carry that can be considered natives.
